Celebrating the first Australian graduates in the Sustainability Champions Scholarship program

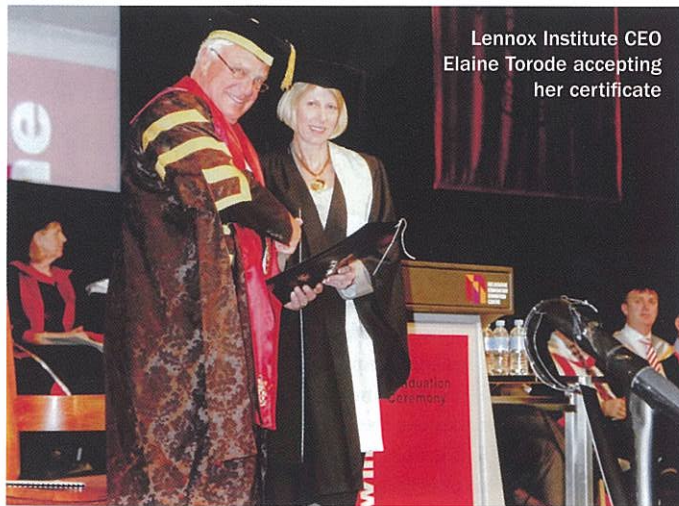
Elaine Torode, CEO of Lennox Institute was part of the first cohort to recently graduate from Swinburne University of Technology in Australasia's first Vocational Graduate Certificate in Education and Training for Sustainability.

The innovative program enhances the skills of teachers (VET, University Higher Education, Secondary and Primary), educators and facilitators in Education for Sustainability (EfS) while developing skills and knowledge to:

- Embed sustainability into learning programs,
- Facilitate delivery and assessment strategies to support change for sustainability
- Plan and implement learning based change programs
- Research current and emerging best practices in their industry sector/field of study

Education for Sustainability (EfS) is now recognised internationally as the educational and pedagogical platform for teaching in sustainability and to stimulate change towards sustainability. While there are an increasing number of courses in Australia *about* sustainability, this qualification is the first focussing on education *for* sustainability.
